"Grants for Grants" - the idea of promoting Polish research topics

System for supporting the preparation of FP7 projects in Poland

Grants for preparation of proposals for Polish entities acting as coordinators of FP7 projects. Provider – Ministry of Science and Higher Education.

Grant is open for legal entities, not individual researchers and is intended to cover costs of proposal preparatory phase.

The main goals of this supporting action are:

- To increase the amount of proposals coordinated by Polish organizations and funding gained by Polish participants from FP7
- To create efficient measure to encourage participation, increase the level of FP7 experience of research organizations.
- To speed up the process of integration of Polish organizations with European Research Area.

Maximum financing per project - up to 100% of the documented costs of preparation but max. 50.000 PLN (about 12 500 EUR). Additional limit: personnel costs eligible up to 25.000 PLN (about 6 250 EUR).
